  - i. Lack of Workforce
    - 1. Josh asked what is the main reason for the lack of workforce in our region?
      - a. Lack of Pay
        - i. Some much education for such little pay
        - ii. The Value in Child Care workers are not seen so the money isn't being put into the workforce around ECEC.
        - iii. We want workers to be paid more but don't want the parents to have to pay more.
        - iv. Make it an economic issue if you want people to need childcare for you to go to work. We need someone in Charge to make it happen.



- 1. Putting funding in the right places is the major issue of our lifetime, funding is going to the wrong places. We need to create a strong bridge to where the funding comes from in order to get the funds to the correct places. (Josh)
- 2. From our end it looks like going to Springfield and to elected officials with both councils and showing the "strength in numbers" and showing what the problem is and how we need help.
  - a. Organize a big group to go and speak with everyone.
- 3. We need to acknowledge that the learning structure has changed and the workforce has changed.
  - a. Schools and colleges align with Preschools and Child Care Centers to get Field hours and Hands on Learning like Trade Classes.
