 - a) How many mental and behavioral health providers are available in the Region
 - Our Region has the following mental and behavioral health providers in our area.
 - o 2 Hospitals
 - o 5 Pediatricians/General Physicians
 - o 27 Physicians
 - 1 Community Mental Health Center
 - o 271 Mental & Behavioral Health Providers
 - o 15 Board Certified Behavior Analysts
 - o 2 Home Visiting Programs
 - b) Where in the Region are the mental and behavioral health services and supports located?
 - Most of the mental and behavioral health services are located in Danville, with only a few in rural areas.
 - c) Who is missing out on the opportunity to connect with mental and behavioral health services and supports due to their location? Why?
 - Families in the rural area could be missing out due to no transportation.



- **d)** How does the number and/or location of providers impact caregivers, **children, and families?**
 - The region does not have very many providers that see young children and only a few of these providers see families with Medicaid.
- e) What experiences have families/caregivers had with the referral process for mental and/or behavioral health services?
 - The referral process takes a long time and families have to follow up with the process to be able to be seen in a reasonable amount of time.
 - The top three places families reported getting referrals for mental and/or behavioral health services:
 - o Doctor/Pediatrician
 - o I didn't get a referral, I just looked for help on my own
 - Early Intervention Staff
- f) How do wait times for mental and behavioral health services impact families in the Region?
 - Some families have to wait so long that they finally give up.
- g) What experiences did caregivers share in the survey that should be highlighted/discussed?
 - On average, families reported waiting several months from referral to receiving mental and/or behavioral health services.
- h) What questions do Council members have for mental and/or behavioral health providers, agencies, organizations and/or non-profit organizations?
